USING THE TSL TO TURN PATIENT

Attach two straps closest to patient's middle area: close to patient's shoulder and hip





SUPINE TRANSFER

Generally use the same length loop all the way down



SEMI-RECLINED TRANSFER

Generally use short loop for strap 1 and the longer loop for the rest of the straps Attach strap 5 if patient tolerates leg hyperextension - otherwise, leave strap unattached



DISCLAIMERS

- water if soiled by patient.
- Discontinue use if loose stitching or tears are visible. • Do not use with an

uncleared C-Spine.
