A-TSLECO (4pt hanger bar)



LOOP

- placed between patient and sling. • Label should be at patient's foot.
- Pillow may be placed
- between legs for comfort.

NOTE: The attachment configurations shown are a general guideline. Please adhere to your hospital's policy and use your clinical judgment as to what best meets your patient's needs.

USING THE TSL TO TURN PATIENT

Attach two straps closest to patient's middle area: close to patient's shoulder and hip

SUPINE TRANSFER

Generally use the same length loop all the way down



SEMI-RECLINED TRANSFER

Generally use short loop for strap 1 and the longer loop for the rest of the straps Attach strap 5 if patient tolerates leg hyperextension - otherwise, leave strap unattached



Cleaning Instructions

- Wash temp not to exceed 185F / 85C
- Dry temp not to exceed 145F / 74C
- Oxygen based bleach solutions only
- Max load 850lbs cycle
- 90 Day Warranty

DISCLAIMERS

- Discontinue use if loose stitching or tears are visible.
- Do not use with an uncleared C-Spine.
